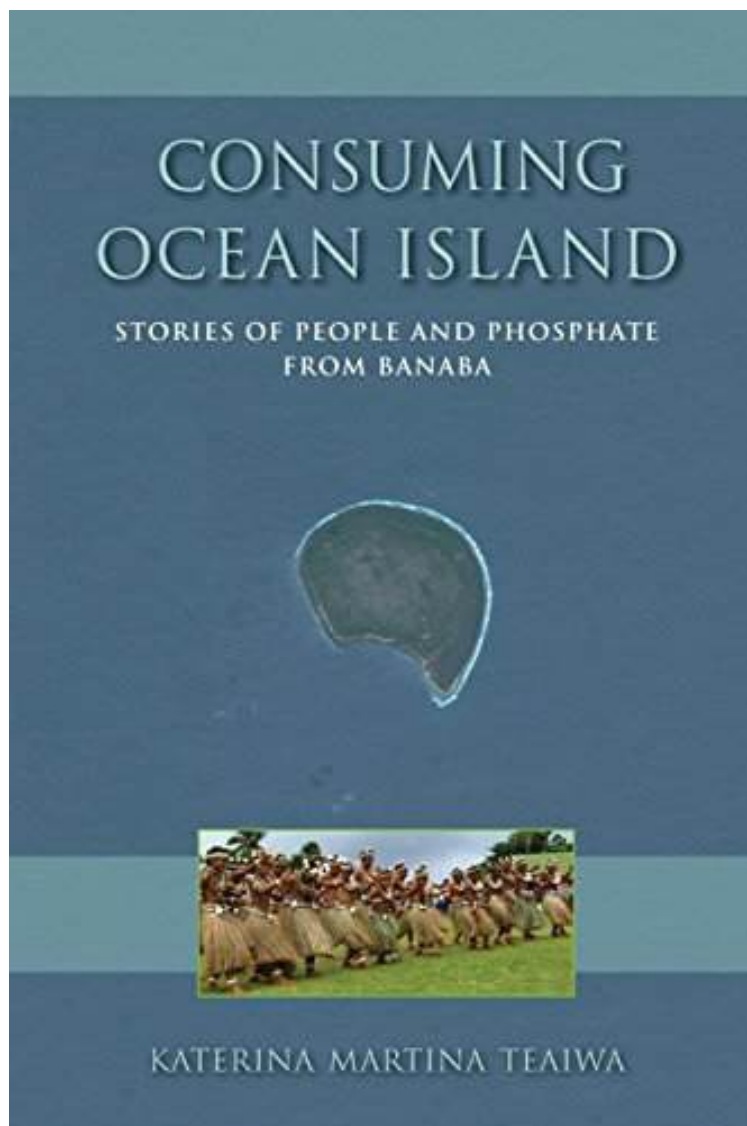


Consuming Ocean Island: Stories of People and Phosphate from Banaba (Tracking Globalization)
