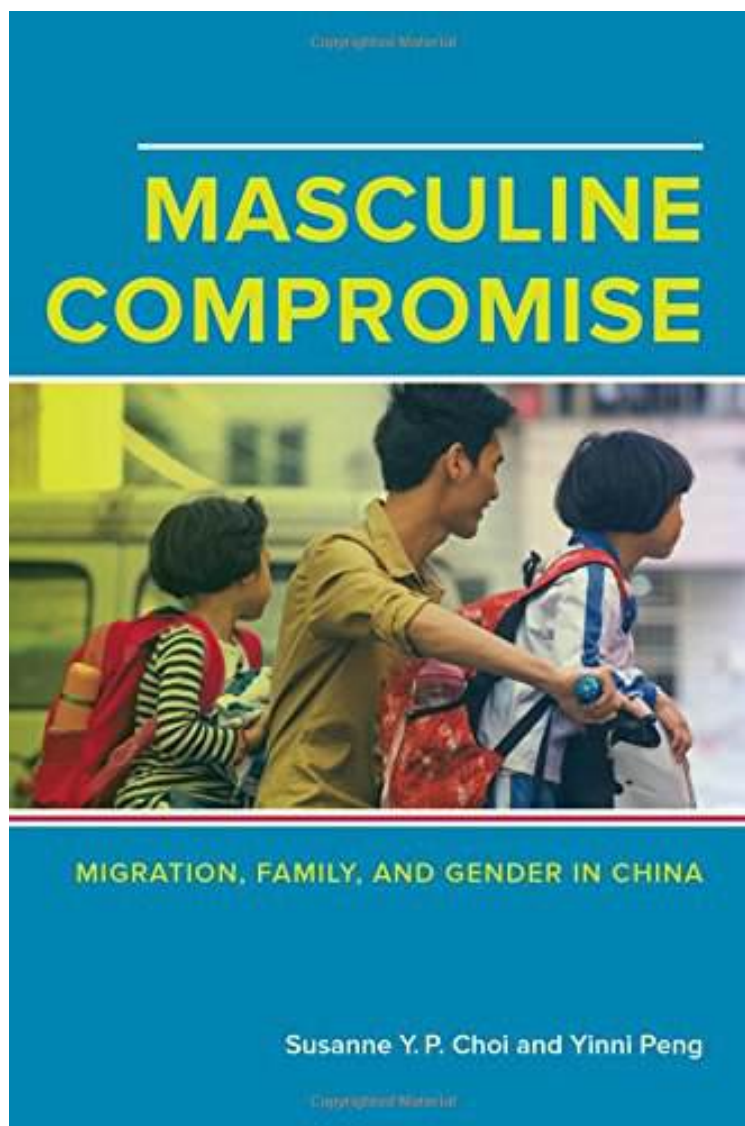


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Masculine Compromise: Migration, Family, and Gender in China
