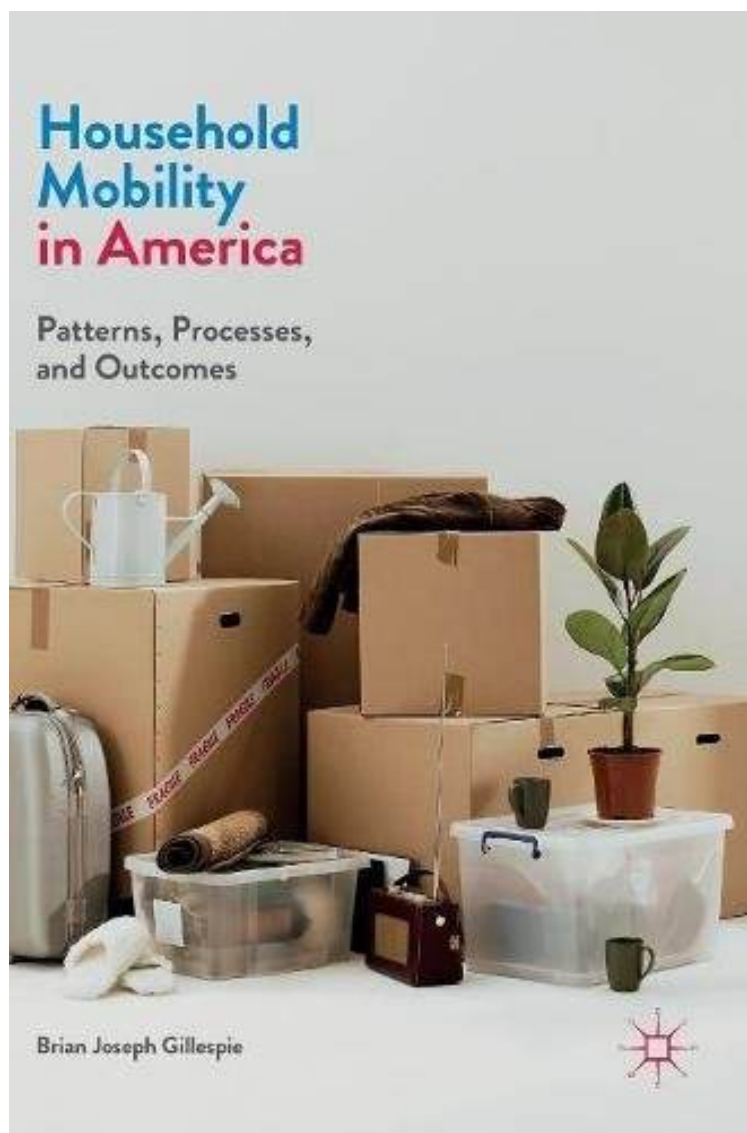


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Household Mobility in America: Patterns, Processes, and Outcomes
