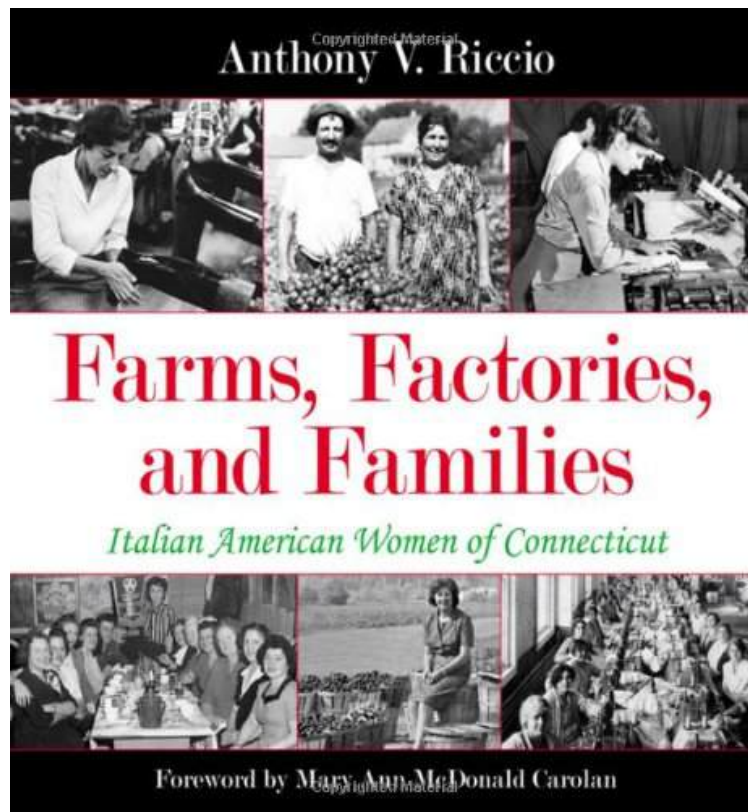


# Farms, Factories, and Families: Italian American Women of Connecticut
