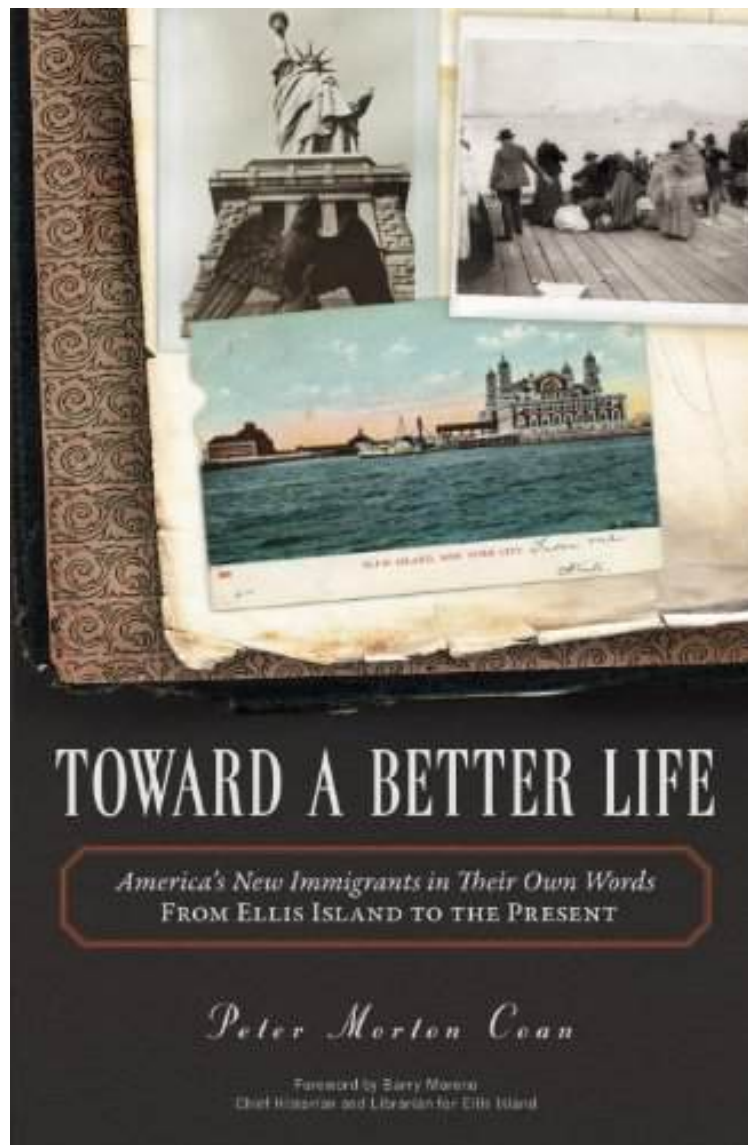


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0 of 0 review helpful Disappointed By kathie I was hoping the stories would be similar to Mr Coan s first book Ellis Island Interviews Half this book dealt with recent affluent immigrants who really didn t struggle to come to America like the poor who came through Ellis Island I found it difficult to feel the emotion of people who just hopped on a plane and in a matter of hours were here I totally skipped over all t This book offers a balanced poignant and often moving portrait of America rsquo s immigrants over more than a century The author has organized the book by decades so that readers can easily find the time period most relevant to their experience or that of family members The first part covers the Ellis Island era the second part America rsquo s new immigrants mdash from the closing of Ellis Island in 1955 to the present Also included is a comprehensive appendix of s a welcome reminder that the vast majority of today s newcomers are tomorrow s productive citizens and that they gravitate here for the same reasons their predecessors did for centuries some of them even become the anti foreigners of the future

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
